## STARTING POINT


Taking responsibility for yourself, a family, team, company, country, organisation or society in the long term

This is only possible in the long term if leaders are honest with themselves. Crucial is the realisation that taking care of ourselves is the most important investment we can make – because we ourselves (body, mind, spirit) are ultimately the only instrument we have to meet life's challenges and live our lives in a successful way. Responsibility for oneself is considered an indispensable prerequisite for responsibility for others.

The first step is to examine yourself to understand how you became the person you are. Most people don't seem to know that. It is helpful here to take a break from the influence of your everyday work routine for a few days (Epictetus) in order to reflect physically, mentally and spiritually on your own life and management path ("past, current and future"). The goal is development work toward becoming an autonomous leader whose external impact is linked to lived values. The result is clarity as well as mental, physical and spiritual armour against challenging and sometimes even threatening life circumstances!



## MARKUS WORTMANN


